

FELCH TOWNSHIP WASTE TRANSFER STATION

Hours of Operation:

Wednesdays 4 p.m. – 7 p.m

Saturdays 8 a.m. – 12 noon.

The Waste Transfer Station is for the use of Felch Township Residents only with the exception of recyclable metals or compost area. We reserve the discretion to limit quantities to the site attendant.

We encourage recycling whenever possible. It reduces your cost and it's good for the environment. The large household dumpster is provided twice a year. In the spring usually the first week in May and in the Fall usually the last week in September. Check with the attendant for dates. Building materials, hazardous waste, refrigeration equipment and electronics for example are never accepted. Automotive – Lead Acid Batteries are accepted the attendant will direct you where to place the batteries for recycling. To dispose of hazardous waste contact the Dickinson County Transfer Station behind the Tri-

Household Garbage Only

All garbage placed in dumpster must be in bags tied shut.

No loose garbage dumped in dumpsters.

All cardboard must be broken down.

No hazardous waste.

No large plastic items, must fit in a bag.


No construction materials.

No yard waste (leaves, grass etc...)

We can and will limit the quantity of bags disposed each time.
